Warren County Sheriff Kevin Harrison reports the arrest of a 52 year old man from Wright City Missouri on July 7, 2011 for charges of Burglary, Assault, Possession of a Controlled Substance, and Resisting Arrest. The charges originated from a 911 call pertaining to the suspect breaking into a residence while armed with a shotgun. The suspect was identified as:



Perry L. Crawford, W, M, 52 Years Old
23000 Block of Tony Drive, Wright City, MO
Burglary 1st Degree, Assault 3rd Degree
Assault on Law Enforcement 3rd Degree, Resisting Arrest
Possession of Controlled Substance
\$45,000.00 Cash Bond

On July 7, 2011 at approximately 2:52am WCSO Corporal JD Sinclair and Deputy Mark Storzer were dispatched to the area of Tony Drive to investigate a report of the suspect breaking into a residence, and running around through the neighborhood armed with a shotgun. Upon arrival to Tony Drive the suspect had already fled the area on foot. While at the Tony Drive location a second 911 call was received regarding an armed suspect that had broken a window and entered a nearby residence on Cardinal Lane. Upon arrival at the Cardinal Lane residence the deputies took Crawford into custody as he was exiting the residence. Crawford physically resisted arrest, assaulted one of the deputies, and had to be physically restrained. A search warrant was later executed at Crawford's residence and a substance believed to be methamphetamines was located and seized. Due to Crawford's status of being on parole from the Missouri Department of Corrections his parole was violated and he was transported back to prison on the morning of July 11, 2011.
