Warren County Sheriff Kevin Harrison reports the arrest of a 26 year old male suspect, the recovery of stolen property, and the discovery of numerous clandestine methamphetamine laboratories being operated in a residence located at 921 West Booneslick in Warrenton Missouri.

The arrest and lab discovery were the result of a search warrant that was executed around 4:30am on the morning of March 21, 2011 by members of the Warren County Sheriff's Department, the Montgomery County Sheriff's Department, and the East Central Drug Task Force. The search warrant was the result of an ongoing burglary and theft investigation from Montgomery County and an ongoing investigation into the possession and manufacturing of methamphetamines in Warren County. The suspect was identified as:



Bryan C. Lang, W, M, 26 Years Old
900 Block of West Booneslick in Warrenton Missouri
Manufacturing a Controlled Substance
Possession of Controlled Substance
Bond: \$35,000.00 Cash or Surety

Detectives located and seized the components, equipment, ingredients, and waste products from over thirty (30) separate methamphetamine laboratories from inside the residence, the trash, and the property behind the residence. Due to the volume of hazardous materials discovered at the site the Missouri Department of Natural Resources Hazardous Materials Team was called to assist in the recovery, transportation, and disposal of over one-hundred (100) pounds of hazardous material waste products.

In addition to the meth labs the detectives recovered several thousand dollars worth of tools and other property stolen from business burglaries that occurred in Montgomery County.
