Warren County Sheriff Kevin Harrison reports the arrest of two females from the Warrenton area on April 2, 2010 for charges related to a residential burglary that had occurred in Truesdale on the previous day. The investigation was handled by Deputies Mark Storz, Andrew Huston, and Paul Fricke. The suspects were identified as:

The burglary occurred at a residence in the Belair subdivision in Truesdale. Upon returning home the victim found the front door to her residence forced open and numerous items stolen. Some of the items stolen included a .22 rifle, laptop computer, Playstation PSP, games, and other miscellaneous items. Initial suspects identified as a result of interviews with the victim. Upon making contact with the suspects the deputies found them to be in possession of the stolen items. In addition to the stolen items the deputies seized a quantity of unknown pills and drug paraphernalia.

Sheriff Harrison commends the prompt response and thorough follow-up investigation conducted by the deputies handling the case. Within 7 hours of the burglary being reported the deputies had the two suspects in custody and the property recovered.
