Warren County Sheriff Kevin Harrison reports charges being filed against the owner of Kelly's Limousine Service, a company based out of Belleville Illinois, for property damage to the Konstanz Gate at Innsbrook Estates. The suspect was identified as:

Larry, R. Mcphail, W, M, 57 Years Old
Fairview Drive, Fairview Heights Illinois
First Degree Property Damage
Bond Set at \$10,000.00 Cash or Surety

The charges stem from an incident that occurred on April 28, 2013 when an employee of the limousine service was dropping a client off inside Innsbrook and attempted to turn around at a closed gate and became stuck off the roadway. After trying to get the vehicle unstuck for over an hour the employee eventually called the company owner who responded for assistance. The suspect forced the gate open causing approximately \$4,305.00 in damage to the gate and electronic controls.

The suspect was initially contacted regarding taking responsibility for the damage and making full restitution, and his respond was to prove that he was responsible. Innsbrook Security contacted the Warren County Sheriff's Department for a criminal investigation and the case was assigned to Deputy Tommy Tomlin for the initial investigation, and then to Lieutenant Scott Schoenfeld for follow-up investigation. Video surveillance evidence was collected, as well as witness statements, and the case was submitted to the Warren County Prosecuting Attorney's Office for the above formal charges. Arrangements are being made at this time for the suspect to surrender himself on the charges.
