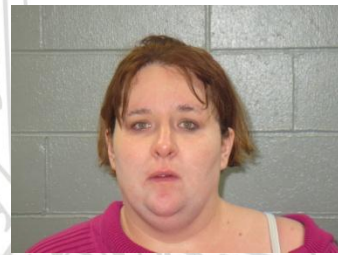
Warren County Sheriff Kevin Harrison reports charges being filed against eight suspects for attempting to manufacture methamphetamine. The suspects were identified as:

The charges are the result of an ongoing investigation by WCSD Lieutenant Scott Schoenfeld into suspects manufacturing, possessing, using, and selling methamphetamine throughout Warren County. Schoenfeld's investigation focused on identifying and intercepting suspects gathering, purchasing, and sometimes stealing the necessary equipment and chemicals required to manufacture the illegal drug. Investigation determined that on April 9, 2013 the above eight suspects were gathering pseudoephedrine pills for the purpose of supplying to a third person knowing they would be used to manufacture methamphetamine.
